
#### Q1 What do you value most about living in the Parish?(Select UP TO SIX that you most value)





## Q2 Which of the following amenities in the Parish do you value most? (Select UP TO SIX that you most value)









#### Q8 If more homes were to be built between now and 2033 (15 years), what level of development would be appropriate? (tick ONE ONLY)





#### Q9 Would you agree to building affordable housing for people on low or modest incomes with a local connection if there was a proven need?





# Q10 Should our plan have a policy which encourages and supports self-build homes for local people?





#### Q11 What type of development is appropriate to accommodate new homes in the Parish?(Please select ALL those you feel are appropriate)





## Q12 Where should any building development be located?(Please select as many or as few as you think are appropriate)





# Q13 New development (including extensions) should be sympathetic to its surroundings



# Q14 Landscaping should be in harmony with the characteristic surrounding area







# Q16 Dark Skies are important - efforts should be made to create specifications for street lights





#### Q17 The size and mix of buildings are important



# Q18 Infill development should respect/maintain adequate space between existing housing





# Q19 Provide adequate external amenity space for refuse and recycling storage








# Q22 Which road(s) cause(s) you most concern?(please state the road(s) and your primary concern)


#### Q24 Do you use buses in the Parish?



# Q27 Do you agree that Important Local Green Spaces should be designated in order that they might receive similar protection from development as our listed buildings?









# Q32 Do you work in Lamberhurst Parish?






# Q37 If you work from home, how satisfied are you with the telecoms infrastructure?



## Q39 If you do not work from home, where do you work?






# Q44 Do you have dependents living in your house (please state how many for each age group)?
